Universitas Putra Indonesia "YPTK" and Universiti Teknologi Malaysia agree to establish communicative and cooperative relation and agree on the following items:

- Both parties agree to promote the following exchange programs based on their respective academic and educational needs.
 - a. Joint research activities and meetings for education and research;
 - b. Exchange of faculty members for the development of both parties;
 - c. Student exchange program;
 - d. Joint collaboration in visiting professor;
 - e. International Seminar;
 - f. Exchange culture;
 - g. Other international collaboration and exchange programs that may be agreed upon by both parties
- This LoI is non-binding expression of the current intention of the parties, and neither
 party will incur nor be bound by any legal or financial obligations hereunder to the
 other party. The implementation of each program of this LoI shall be negotiated and
 determined by both parties.
- For the purpose of implementing the collaboration in respect of any areas stated in paragraph 1, the parties will negotiate and conclude a legally binding agreement containing mutually agreed terms and conditions suitable to the implementation of such collaboration.

- 4. Contact Persons: Within three months after the mutual signing both institution will name a contact person from Universitas Putra Indonesia "YPTK" (Dr. Syafrika Deni Rizki, S.Kom., M.Kom kerma@upiyptk.ac.id) and from Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (Associate Prof. Dr. Mohd Shahizan bin Othman, +60127363269, shahizan@utm.my) responsible for any issues in the context of this agreement.
- 5. This LoI shall be in force for two (2) years and shall be subject to revision or extension by mutual agreement. This LoI may be terminated by either party in written notice of no less than three (3) months prior to the termination date.
