The last conclusion section is short. ❖ Suggestions to Author/s	
A section of literature review can be created and discussed in more details. The paper needs to detail out the methodology. Improve the conclusion section by clarifying what are the limits of your research and explaining how they open up avenues for future studies on the topic.	

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
